SPECIAL CONSTABLES.

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor has been pleased to commission additional members of the Loyal Manx Association to act as Special Constables (unpaid) until further orders.

His Excellency has authorized in addition to the special duties referred to in Government Circular No. 93 a guard of Special Constables being mounted nightly at the Aliens' Detention Camp between such hours and in such strength as shall be arranged from time to time between the Commandant of the Aliens' Camp and the Chief Constable. Special Constables detailed for this duty may, if the Chief Constable so order, carry rifles and ball ammunition. They will act under the orders of the Commandant, Aliens Camp, whilst at the Camp.
