## SPECIAL CONSTABLES.

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor has been pleased to Commission certain members of the Loyal Maux Association in the Peel District to act as Special Constables (unpaid) until further orders for the purpose of assisting the Police and Military in regulating the traffic for the progress of detachments of Prisoners of War from Peel Harbour to Knockaloe Detention Camp and for assisting at Knockaloe Detention Camp in the event of the Commandant requisitioning their services.

Special Constables detailed for these duties may, if the Chief Constable so order, carry rifles and ball ammunition. If called on for duty at the Knockaloe Detention Camp Special Constables will take orders from the Commandant of the Camp.
