



THE COURTS (EMERGENCY POWERS) RULES, 1914.

Under the authority conferred upon them by Section 1 (4) of the Schedule attached to the Order of His Majesty in Council, dated the 14th day of October 1914, extending the operation of the Courts (Emergency Powers) Act 1914 to the Isle of Man, the Judges of the Insular High Court of Justice have issued Rules for the purpose of giving full effect to the Act within the Island.
