SPECIAL CONSTABLES.

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor has been pleased to commission certain members of the Loyal Manx Association in the Port Erin District to act as Special Constables (unpaid) until further orders, for the purpose of assisting the Police and Military by mounting a Guard over Port Erin Harbour.

Special Constables detailed for this duty may, if the Chief Constable so order, carry rifles and ball ammunition. If called on for duty with troops they will act under the command of the Officer commanding the troops.
