DEFENCE OF THE REALM.

Right of Access to Land, Buildings, or other Private Property.

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, as Competent Military Authority, has issued a Warrant under the Defence of the Realm Consolidation Regulations, authorising any member of the Isle of Man Constabulary, any Special Constable, or any member of His Majesty's Forces to have right of access to any land, buildings, or other property whatsoever, if for the purpose of the Defence of the Realm it is necessary for him in the execution of his duty to have such access.

Superior Officers must secure that this authority is not improperly used.

A copy of the Warrant is appended.

DEFENCE OF THE REALM (CONSOLIDATION) REGULATIONS.

REGULATION 3.

WHEREAS under Regulation 3 of the Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations it is lawful for the competent Naval or Military Authority and any person duly authorised by him to have right of access to any land or buildings or other property whatsoever.

NOW I do hereby authorize any member of the Isle of Man Constabulary, any Special Constable or any member of His Majesty's Forces to have such right of access if for the purpose of the Defence of the Realm it is necessary for him in execution of his duty to enter private land, buildings or other property whatsoever.
