



EXTINGUISHING AND OBSCURING OF LIGHTS.

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, as Competent Military Authority, has issued an Order, a copy of which is appended, under Regulation 12 of the Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914, directing that all lights, other than those used for purposes of navigation or for Detention Camps, which are visible seawards shall be kept extinguished or obscured until further Order.

DEFENCE OF THE REALM (CONSOLIDATION) REGULATIONS, 1914.

REGULATION, 12.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by Regulation 12 of the Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914, I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the said Isle, being a Competent Military Authority, do hereby make the following Order :—

All lights, other than those used for the purposes of navigation or for Detention Camps, which are visible seawards shall be kept extinguished or obscured until further order.
