



Closing of Licensed Premises to Members of His Majesty's Forces.

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, as Competent Military Authority, has issued an Order (a copy of which is appended), excluding from the operation of the Order of the 5th instant (Government Circular, No. 126), such Members of His Majesty's Forces who are on licensed premises during prohibited hours, with sanction in writing from the Government Office.

Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914.

REGULATION 10.

Whereas, on the 5th day of March, 1915, I made an Order closing all premises licensed for the Sale of Intoxicating Liquor within the Isle of Man to all Members of His Majesty's Forces, except between the hours of 12 noon and 8 p.m. I hereby Order that such Order shall not be applicable in the case of any Member of His Majesty's Forces who has permission in writing from the Government Office to be present on licensed premises between the hours of 8 p.m. and 12 noon.
