



## BONFIRES, FIREWORKS, &c.

---

Attention is directed to Regulation 26 of the Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914, which provides that no person shall, without the permission of the Competent Military Authority or some person authorised by him, display any light, or ignite or otherwise make use of any fireworks or other similar device, or any fire in such a manner as could serve as a signal, guide, or landmark, and if he does so he shall be guilty of an offence against the Regulations.
