



CLOSING F LI ENSED PREMISES.

HIS Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, as Competent Military Authority, has issued an Order (a copy of which is appended) under the Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914, closing the Foxdale Hotel, Foxdale, absolutely to all members of His Majesty's Forces from the 21st instant.

The Lieutenant-Governor further desires to warn the proprietors of all licensed premises that drastic steps will be taken in the case of any proprietor who fails to comply with existing regulations, resulting, perhaps, in the closing of the house to the public as well as to members of His Majesty's Forces.

DEFENCE OF THE REALM (CONSOLIDATION) REGULATIONS, 1914.

REGULATION 10.

IN pursuance of the power conferred on me by Regulation 10 of the Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914, I, being a Competent Military Authority, do hereby make the following Order :—

The Licensed Premises known as the "Foxdale Hotel," Foxdale, shall be closed absolutely to all Members of His Majesty's Forces from Friday, the 21st May, 1915, until further Order.
