**REGULATION 38.**

---

**YACHTING RESTRICTIONS.**

---

THE Naval Authorities have ordered that no cruising of yachts or pleasure boats will be permitted off the Manx coast except in the case of those yachts and boats licensed by the Lieutenant-Governor to proceed within a two-mile radius of the ports of Douglas, Peel, and Ramsey respectively.

Applications for licences, which are independent of those issued by the Harbour Commissioners, must give full particulars as to the vessel and port where it is to be used, and must be made in writing, addressed to the Government Secretary, Douglas.

The owner of any unlicensed yacht or pleasure boat which proceeds to sea after the date hereof, and the owner of any licensed yacht or pleasure boat found exceeding the two-mile radius above referred to, will be liable to the penalties conferred by the Defence of the Realm Act.
