



## CLOSING OF RETAIL LIQUOR PREMISES.

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, as Competent Military Authority, has issued an order (a copy of which is appended) under the Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914, compelling the holder of a retail liquor licence to close his premises for the sale or delivery of intoxicating liquors except between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7-30 p.m.

*DEFENCE OF THE REALM (CONSOLIDATION) REGULATIONS, 1914.*

### **REGULATION 10.**

IN pursuance of the power conferred on me by the Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914, I, being a Competent Military Authority, do hereby order that all persons now, or at any time hereafter, holding a retail liquor licence as defined by the Licensing Act, 1876, shall close the premises in respect of which such licence is granted, for the sale or delivery of intoxicating liquors, except between the hours of seven o'clock in the forenoon and seven-thirty o'clock in the afternoon.
