



## Restrictions on the Cruising of Yachts and Pleasure Boats.

---

ON and after July 7th, 1915, the Naval Authorities will permit Yachts and Pleasure Boats to proceed to sea from the Port of Castletown within the limits of a two mile radius from the Pier Head.

Cruising will only be permitted between sunrise and one hour after sunset, and the owner of every Yacht or Pleasure Boat proceeding to sea, must be in possession of a special Licence, issued for the purpose by Authority of the Lieutenant-Governor.

Applications for licences, which are independent of those issued by the Harbour Commissioners, must be made in writing, giving full particulars as to the vessel, and must be addressed to the Government Secretary, Government Office, Isle of Man.
