



Supplying Intoxicants to Members of His Majesty's Forces.

Public attention is directed to Regulation 40 of the Defence of the Realm Regulations which lays down **“if any person gives or sells to a member of His Majesty's Forces any intoxicant when not on duty, with intent to make him drunk or less capable of the efficient discharge of his duties, or when on sentry or other duty, either with or without any such intent, he shall be guilty of an offence against the Regulations.”**

In view of the fact that all troops stationed at the Alien Detention Camps in the Island are on “active service,” publicans are advised to exercise the greatest care in serving Members of His Majesty's Forces with intoxicants, and members of the public should refrain from treating soldiers and sailors to drink.
