DEFENCE OF THE REALM (CONSOLIDATION) REGULATIONS, 1914.

REGULATION 10.

Whereas on the 5th day of March, 1915, and the 10th day of July, 1915, I made Orders (copies of which were circulated in Government Circulars Nos. 126 and 152 respectively) under powers vested in me by Regulation 10 of the Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914, requiring the closing of all premises licensed for the sale of intoxicating liquor within the Isle of Man to all members of His Majesty's Forces, entirely on Sundays and on week-days entirely except between the hours of 12 noon and 8-0 p.m., and whereas it is desirable to exempt from the scope of such Orders Commissioned Officers of His Majesty's Forces, I do hereby order that my Orders of the 5th day March, 1915, and the 10th day of July, 1915, shall not operate in the case of Commissioned Officers of His Majesty's Forces.
