



DEFENCE OF THE REALM.

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor desires it to be known that His Majesty has been pleased by Order in Council, dated the 14th September, 1915, made under the Isle of Man (War Legislation) Act, 1914, to extend to the Isle of Man the Regulations amending the Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914, issued by His Majesty by Order in Council dated the 28th day of July 1915, subject to the following adaptations:—

In Regulation 18A (*b*), after the words "United Kingdom," there shall be read the words "and the Isle of Man."

In Regulation 51A, delete the words "quarter sessions" to the end of the paragraph, and substitute the words "in manner provided by Section 14 of the Petty Sessions Act, 1864."
