



CLOSING OF ROADWAY TO VICTORIA MOUNT

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, as Competent Military Authority, has issued an Order (a copy of which is appended), under the Defence of the Realm Regulations, closing the roadway leading from Victoria Road to Victoria Mount, which latter now forms part of Douglas Detention Camp.

The Commandant of Douglas Detention Camp will cause a Light to be exhibited nightly on this Barrier across the Road.

Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914.

REGULATION 5.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by the Defence of the Realm Regulations, I do hereby make the following Order:—

The roadway leading from Victoria Road, Douglas, to Victoria Mount, Douglas, shall be closed to the public until further order, and a barrier shall be erected across the roadway.
