



TRADING WITH THE ENEMY.

A PROCLAMATION, dated 29th February, 1916, has been issued by His Majesty the King prohibiting trading with certain persons, or bodies of persons, of enemy nationality or enemy association carrying on business in Greece, Morocco, The Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Portuguese East Africa, Spain, and Sweden.

The list may be inspected on application at Government Office, and all persons trading with any of the countries named are advised to consult the list before entering into a transaction with a person or firm in any of such countries.
