



DEFENCE OF THE REALM.

HIS MAJESTY THE KING has been graciously pleased, by Order in Council, dated 23rd May, 1916, made under the Isle of Man (War Legislation) Act, 1914, to extend to the Isle of Man the provisions of the Order in Council of 26th April, 1916, amending the Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914.

The only amendment effected by this Order in Council is in regulation 58A the word "minor" shall be omitted.
