DEFENCE OF THE REALM.

REPEAL OF THE BUTTER ORDER, 1918.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR has issued an Order under the Defence of the Realm Regulations, dated 26th January, 1920 (a copy of which is appended), directing that the Butter Order, 1918, shall be revoked as from 1st February, 1920. The effect of the Order is that butter, except imported Government Butter, becomes de-controlled as from the date specified.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the Defence of the Realm Regulations, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby order that the Butter Order, 1918, with the several amendments issued thereunder shall be revoked as from 1st February, 1920, but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect to any contravention thereof.

This Order does not affect the Butter (Distribution) Order, 1917, regulating the disposal and price of Government Butter, which remains in force.
