Removal of Police Officer's Furniture.

When a Police Officer is transferred from one district to another, the expenses to be borne by public funds in connection with the removal of his furniture will be limited to the amounts shewn in the scale appended. Claims must be approved by the Chief Constable, who will certify them as correct.

(a) Married Officers:—

12/6 per mile up to 6 miles.

10/- per mile up to 12 miles and more than 6, with a minimum allowance of £3 15s. od.

8/- per mile exceeding 12 miles, with a minimum allowance of £6 os. od.

(b) Single Officers:—

Actual out-of-pocket expenses.
