### ***ISLE OF MAN TO WIT.***

BY HIS EXCELLENCY MAJOR-GENERAL WILLIAM FRY, C.B., C.V.O.  
LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR OF THE SAID ISLE, etc., etc.

WHEREAS under the Animals (Repeal of Importation Restrictions on Horses) Order, 1920, horses may be imported into this Isle without being subjected to quarantine and veterinary inspection.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, DO HEREBY revoke and repeal the Order dated 13th day of May, 1918, made by the Lieutenant-Governor, declaring the Mitre Hotel Stables in Water Street, Ramsey, to be "Government Lairs" for the purposes of the Animals Importation Orders, and on and from the date hereof such Order shall and the same is hereby rendered null and void.
