HIS EXCELLENCY THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR wishes it to be publicly known that the Summer Time (Isle of Man) Act, 1916, will be in force during the year 1920, and the prescribed period will be from **2 a.m.** (Greenwich Mean Time) on Sunday, 28th March, until **2 a.m.** (Greenwich Mean Time) on Monday, 27th September.

All clocks in the Isle of Man should be advanced one hour as from 2 a.m. on Sunday, 28th March.
