ISLE OF MAN.

Cattle Diseases (Prevention) Acts.

Notice to Farmers, Dealers and all Importers of Animals.

1. Imported animals must be taken immediately to the place of destination specified in the permit without coming into contact with other animals.
2. Imported animals must on arrival at the place of destination be kept isolated for a period of 14 days.
3. Imported animals may be moved from the place of destination for immediate slaughter within 14 days, but during movement must not be allowed to come into contact with other animals.
4. If any animal shows any sign of illness, or any appearance of skin disease, the owner must at once notify the police at the nearest Police Station.
5. If any imported animal should die, notice must be given immediately to the nearest Police Station.
