***SUGAR (RATIONING) ORDER, 1918.***

---

NOTICE OF INCREASE IN WEEKLY SUGAR RATION AND IN  
SUPPLIES TO CATERING ESTABLISHMENTS, &c.

---

In exercise of the powers reserved to him by the above Order, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Lieutenant-Governor hereby determines that as from March 22nd, 1920, until further notice, the Sugar Ration shall be increased as follows :—

1. The Domestic Sugar Ration from 6 ozs. to 8 ozs per head per week.
2. The supplies to be allotted to Catering Establishments, etc., from the above date to be :—
  - (a) For each resident at the rate of 4 ozs. per week.
  - (b) For each meal served (breakfast, luncheon, tea, and dinner) at the rate of  $\frac{1}{7}$ th of an ounce, instead of  $\frac{3}{28}$ ths of an ounce.
