BUILDING TRADES DISPUTE.

AWARD OF ARBITRATION BOARD.

THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR has received the following Award of the Arbitration Board, appointed by His Excellency for determining matters in dispute between the Isle of Man Employers' Federation and the Douglas Trades and Labour Council, held on the 20th March, 1920, to arbitrate with regard to—

1. The Rate of Pay of Sawyers ;
2. The Rates of Pay of Apprentices ;

consideration of which matters was postponed at the meeting of the Board held on the 21st February, 1920.

1.—SAWYERS' PAY.—The decision arrived at at the previous meeting of the Board was confirmed.

2.—APPRENTICES' PAY.—

The above rate applies to Joiners' and Plumbers' Apprentices; Masons' Apprentices to receive the following increases on the above scale:—

1st Year	£0	7	6
2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th	Years...	0	10	0

The above scales to apply to existing and future apprenticeships, whether under formal indenture or otherwise, and to be retrospective to March 1st, 1920.

The above scales not to apply to apprentices under the Government Apprenticeship Scheme.
