**DEFENCE OF THE REALM REGULATIONS.**

HIS MAJESTY THE KING has been graciously pleased by Order in Council dated the 11th March, 1920, made under the provisions of the Isle of Man (War Legislation) Act, 1914, to extend to the Isle of Man the Regulation amending the Defence of the Realm Regulations contained in paragraph 2 of the Order of His Majesty in Council, of the 25th November, 1919.

The Regulation, as extended, is set forth below.

2. In regulation 18A for the words " enemy agent " wherever they occur there shall be substituted the words " foreign agent," and for the definition of " enemy agent " the following definition shall be substituted:

“ “ foreign agent ’ includes any person who is or has been or is reasonably suspected of being or having been employed by a foreign power either directly or indirectly for the purpose of committing an act, either within or without the Isle of Man, prejudicial to the safety or interests of the State, or who has or is reasonably suspected of having, either within or without the Isle of Man, committed or attempted to commit such an act in the interests of a foreign power.”
