DEFENCE OF THE REALM.

**IMPORTED CHEESE (RETAIL PRICES)
ORDER, 1919.**

DIRECTIONS.

In exercise of the powers reserved to him by the above Order, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Lieutenant-Governor hereby orders and directs as follows:—

1. On and after the 29th May, 1920—

(a) The Maximum Retail Prices for Privately Imported Cheese will be removed.

(b) Only Government Imported Cheese distributed by the Ministry of Food shall be sold by retail at a price not exceeding 1s 8d per lb.

2. Where Government Imported Cheese is delivered at the buyer's request otherwise than at the seller's premises, an additional charge may be made in respect of such delivery not exceeding the rate of 4d per lb. or any larger sum actually and properly paid by the seller for carriage.

3. The Directions under Imported Cheese (Retail Prices) Order, 1919, dated the 29th December, 1919, are hereby revoked, but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect to any contravention thereof.
