DEFENCE OF THE REALM.

BUTTER (DISTRIBUTION) ORDER, 1917.

Reduction in the Price of Government Butter.

DIRECTIONS.

In exercise of the powers reserved to him by the above Order, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Lieutenant-Governor hereby directs as follows:—

1. No Government Butter released for distribution under the Butter Distribution Scheme on and after June 28th, 1920, shall, until further notice, be sold by retail at a price exceeding $2/8$ per lb.

2 The price fixed by this Direction is fixed on the basis that the cost of packing and packages is borne by the seller and that no charge is made for giving credit or making delivery, and no Government Butter shall be sold on any other terms.
