REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS ON EXPORTATION OF FOODSTUFFS.

The LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR has issued an Order, dated the 24th June, 1920, a copy of which is appended, revoking the Orders made by the Lieutenant-Governor under the Defence of the Realm Regulations prohibiting the exportation from the Isle of Man of the undermentioned articles of food :—

MEAT OF ALL KINDS (Cooked or Uncooked).
BUTTER AND MARGARINE.
CHEESE.
EGGS.
MILK.
FLOUR (including Oatmeal).

ISLE OF MAN

By His Excellency Major-General WILLIAM FRY, C.B., C.V.O.,
Lieutenant-Governor of the said Isle, etc., etc.

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the Defence of the Realm Regulations, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, do hereby order that the Order made by the Lieutenant-Governor on the 7th day of March, 1917, so far only as it relates to the exportation of oatmeal from the Isle of Man; the Order made by the Lieutenant-Governor on the 18th day of September, 1917, declaring that the expressions "wheat" and "barley" contained in the Order made by him on the 9th day of March, 1917, should include wheat-flour and wheat-meal and barley-flour and barley-meal; Clause 1 of the Eggs and Milk Order, 1917, made by the Lieutenant-Governor on the 28th day of September, 1917; the Order made by the Lieutenant-Governor on the 15th day of October, 1917, prohibiting the exportation of dead-meat from the Isle of Man; the Butter and Cheese Order, 1917, made by the Lieutenant-Governor on the 27th day of October, 1917; The Margarine Order, 1918, made by the Lieutenant-Governor on the 2nd day of February, 1918, shall be, and the same are hereby revoked and cancelled as from the date hereof, without prejudice to any proceedings which may subsequently be taken in respect of any contravention of the Orders hereby revoked prior to their revocation.
