THE SUGAR (RATIONING) ORDER, 1918.

VISITORS' SUGAR.

The Food Controller, in consequence of the closing of a great number of the Local Food Offices in the United Kingdom, has altered the arrangements of the previous Visiting Season with respect to Sugar for Visitors.

From 6th July, 1920, until further notice, all persons leaving home after that date for short periods (i.e., not exceeding Four Weeks) will no longer be able to obtain Sugar from retailers in the district they are visiting, and, therefore, should purchase their supplies in advance before leaving home. To enable visitors to obtain supplies of Sugar from their own retailers, arrangements have been made whereby it is lawful for a retailer to supply three weeks' rations in advance in addition to the current week's ration.
