PROFITEERING ACTS, 1919.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR has made an Order dated July 24th, 1920 (copy of which is appended), under Section 1 of the Profiteering Act, 1919, bringing the following articles within the operation of the Act:—Pen Nibs and Pen Holders; Writing Paper, Pads, Envelopes, and Wrappers; Blotting Paper and Pads; Memorandum, Account and Exercise Books; Packing Paper and Flat Papers; Inks and Gums; Pencils; India Rubber; All Mineral Waters; Home-killed Butcher's Meat; Imported Mutton; Poultry, Game and Rabbits; Eggs; Butter (home produced); Bacon (home produced); Cheese (home produced).

ISLE OF MAN } *By His Excellency Major-General Sir William Fry,*
TO WIT. } *K.C.V.O., C.B., Lieutenant-Governor of the said Isle, Etc., Etc.*

Whereas Section 1 of the Profiteering Act, 1919, provides that the Act may be applied by Order of the Lieutenant Governor to any article or class of articles declared by the Order to be one or one of a kind in common use by the public or being material, machinery, or accessories used in the production of such articles, but that the Act shall not apply to any articles which are from time to time declared to be controlled articles.

Now, therefore, I, the Lieutenant-Governor do hereby declare that the articles, or class of articles set out in the Schedule annexed hereto are articles of a kind in common use by the public, and are articles which are not controlled, and do hereby order that the Profiteering Acts, 1919, shall apply to each and every article or class of articles contained in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order and to each article of food specifically mentioned in Part 2 of the Schedule hereto.

This Order shall come into force forthwith, and may be cited as the Profiteering Acts, 1919, Order (No. 5).
