DEFENCE OF THE REALM.

Revocation of the Bacon, Hams and Lard (Distribution) Order, 1917.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR has issued an Order under the Defence of the Realm Regulations, dated 31st July, 1920 (a copy of which is appended), directing that the above Order shall be revoked as from August 16th, 1920.

ISLE OF MAN } *By His Excellency Major-General Sir William Fry,*
TO WIT. } *K.C.V.O., C.B., Lieutenant-Governor of the said Isle, Etc., Etc.*

In exercise of the powers reserved to him by the above Order, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Lieutenant-Governor hereby directs that the said Order shall be revoked as from 16th August, 1920, but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect to any contravention thereof.

The Order dissolves the Bacon Control Committee and allows any person to import into the Isle of Man and sell by wholesale Bacon, Ham and Lard according to the Regulations and Schedule in the Imported Bacon, Ham and Lard (Wholesale Prices) Order, 1920.
