**MODIFICATION OF RESTRICTIONS.**

Application may be made to the Police by pig-owners for permits for the movement of swine into, from, and within the Parish of Onchan, in conformity with the following conditions :—

1. No permits will be issued for the movement of swine to the premises known as Conrhenny Farm, Oachan, occupied by Mr Henry J. Nicholl, before the 13th December, 1920.
2. Permits will be issued for the movement of swine into the Parish of Onchan on and after 27th September, 1920.
3. Permits will be issued for the movement of swine out of and within the Parish of Onchan on and after 11th October, 1920, but permits may be applied for, for the movement of swine for immediate slaughter at the Douglas Abattoir on and after 20th September, 1920, provided the animals are moved in a vehicle which must be disinfected in conformity with the terms of the "Animals (Transit) Order, 1914."
4. Permits will be issued for the export of swine from the Isle of Man (other than from the Parish of Onchan) on and after 27th September, 1920.
5. Permits will be issued for the export from the Island of swine in the Parish of Onchan on and after 11th October, 1920.
6. The above conditions will only hold good provided no further outbreak of swine-fever occurs.
