 DEFENCE OF THE REALM REGULATIONS.

In pursuance of Regulation 10B of the Defence of the Realm Regulations, I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, do hereby Order that the operation of the Early Closing of Shops Order, 1920, made by me on the 29th day of March, 1920, and suspended between the 21st day of May and the 30th day of September, 1920, by my Order of the 13th day of May, 1920, shall be further suspended between the 1st day of October and the 31st day of October, 1920, both dates inclusive.
