DEFENCE OF THE REALM.

Sugar (Rationing) Order, 1918.

Notice of Reduction in Weekly Sugar Ration and in Supplies to Catering Establishments, &c.

In exercise of the powers reserved to him by the above Order and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Lieutenant-Governor hereby determines that as from 18th October, 1920, until further notice, the Sugar Ration shall be reduced as follows :—

1. The domestic sugar ration from 12 ozs. to 6 ozs. per head per week.
2. The supplies to be allotted to Catering Establishments, &c., from the above date to be :—
 - (a) For each resident at the rate of 3 ozs. per week.
 - (b) For each meal served (breakfast, luncheon, tea, and dinner) at the rate of three-twentyeighths of an ounce, instead of three-fourteenths of an ounce.
