Isle of Man Coal (Distribution) Order, 1920.

GENERAL LICENCE.

Licensed Dealers (Coal Merchants) for the purposes of the above Order, are hereby authorized to distribute Coal as under;—

FOR DOMESTIC PURPOSES.

At the rate of one cwt. per household per week. To facilitate distribution five weeks' ration (*i.e.*, five cwts.) may be delivered at one time where necessary.

SICK PERSONS, ETC.

Where a medical certificate is produced, one cwt. additional Coal per week may be issued in respect of sick persons, aged persons, and young children of three years and under.

FACTORIES AND WORKSHOPS.

At the rate authorized by the Government Secretary, on the Licensed Dealer submitting an application from the proprietor on the prescribed form.

SHOPS, PUBLIC AND PRIVATE OFFICES.

At the rate of 50 per cent. of their normal average week's consumption for the current year.

HOSPITALS, NURSING HOMES, SCHOOLS, AND HOMES FOR THE AGED, ETC.

At the rate of 75 per cent. of their normal average weekly consumption for the current year.

COAL FOR THRESHING PURPOSES.

At the rate of six cwts. per diem on application being made to the Licensed Dealer on the prescribed form, obtainable from the Licensed Dealer.

HOTELS, BOARDING-HOUSES, AND LODGING-HOUSES.

At the rate of 50 per cent. of their normal average weekly consumption for the current year.

STEAMSHIPS OTHER THAN PLEASURE VESSELS.

With sufficient Coal to make the nearest port.

Cases not provided for herein, will be referred by the Licensed Dealer to the Government Secretary for consideration by the Lieutenant-Governor.
