DEFENCE OF THE REALM REGULATIONS

**WITHDRAWAL OF COAL (DISTRIBUTION)
ORDER, 1920.**

Consequent upon the Coal (Emergency) Order, 1920 (England and Scotland), being suspended as from this date, HIS EXCELLENCY THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR, under powers vested in him by the Defence of the Realm Regulations, has made an Order dated November 16th, 1920 (a copy of which is appended), rescinding the Coal (Distribution) Order dated 19th October, 1920.

Consumers may purchase Coal without restriction, ALTHOUGH THE STRICTEST ECONOMY IS STILL ENJOINED.

DEFENCE OF THE REALM REGULATIONS.

On and after the sixteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and twenty, the Isle of Man Coal (Distribution) Order, dated the nineteenth day of October, nineteen hundred and twenty, together with all Regulations made thereunder, shall cease to operate.
