**SUGAR (RATIONING) ORDER, 1918.**

TRANSFER OF SUGAR TICKETS TO ANOTHER SUGAR  
RETAILER.

---

In exercise of the powers reserved to him by the above Order, the **LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR** hereby determines that as from November 24th to December 8th, 1920, any person may, under the appended Directions, transfer their Sugar Ticket from one Sugar Retailer to another.

1. Any person desirous of changing his Sugar Retailer during the period specified above, must obtain the counter-foil of his Sugar Ticket and surrender the same, together with the Ticket to the **Local Food Control Authority**, when a New Ticket will be issued.

2. Every Sugar Retailer when requested so to do must give up to the purchaser the counter-foil of the Ticket on which his name and address is written, and also any other tickets of which he may have charge.

3. All Executive Officers to the **Local Food Control Authorities** are directed to issue a new Sugar Ticket to any applicant who surrenders his present Sugar Ticket.
