Fee fixed after consultation.

Suitable receptacles for the collection of specimens (outfits) are supplied on application to the Government Laboratory. Specimens **must on no account be sent by parcel post**, but by letter post, conspicuously marked "Fragile, with care," and "Pathological Specimen," and bear the name and address of the sender on the outside of the wrapper, in accordance with the postal regulations.

The Public Analyst will render to the Treasurer of the Isle of Man, monthly, a complete statement of all examinations made during the preceding month. The Treasurer of the Isle of Man will then claim the fees from the Departments or Medical Practitioners concerned.
