**REVOCATION OF THE EARLY CLOSING OF
SHOPS No. 2 ORDER, 1920.**

HIS EXCELLENCY THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR has, under the powers conferred upon him by the Defence of the Realm Regulations, made an Order (a copy of which is appended), dated 4th December, 1920, revoking as from the 6th December, 1920, the Order made by him on the 18th October, 1920, entitled the Early Closing of Shops No. 2 Order, 1920.

The Order removes all restrictions in regard to the closing of Shops and places of Entertainment.

The revocation of the Early Closing of Shops No. 2 Order, 1920, shall not be deemed to revive any of the Orders repealed by such Order.
