MOVEMENT OF SWINE WITHIN, TO, AND FROM THE ISLAND.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR has, under the powers conferred by the Cattle Diseases Prevention Acts and in accordance with the recommendation of a Committee of Tynwald, made a new Order (a copy of which is appended) dated the 18th day of January, 1921, which comes into force on the 1st day of February, 1921, cancelling the existing order governing the movement of swine, and regulating movement as under :—

1. The movement of swine shall in all cases continue to be regulated by licence.

(a) LICENCES to move swine WITHIN the Island may now be obtained, on application either from the Police or from the Clerks to the Village and Parish Commissioners.

(b) Permits to IMPORT swine into the Island shall as heretofore be obtained on application to Government Office.

(c) Licences and counter-signatures to declaration forms to enable swine to be EXPORTED from the Island will in future be obtained on application to the Inspector under the Cattle Diseases Prevention Acts, Murray House, Douglas, and not from the Police Inspectors as hitherto.

No internal movement licence is required from the Police or the Clerks to the Village or Parish Commissioners in the case of swine which are being exported, and in respect of which a licence has been obtained from the Inspector under the Cattle Diseases Prevention Acts for such export.

2. Swine may be licensed to a mart and from the mart to a new destination, or if not sold, back to the farm or other place from which they were removed to the mart, without being kept at the mart for 14 days.

3. Swine may be licensed from one place to another within the Island, but must remain at the second place for 14 days before being licensed to other premises, except where

- (a) they are for immediate slaughter,
- (b) they are removed to a mart for sale,
- (c) they are fat or store swine on the premises of a registered dealer in swine, or
- (d) they are sows being moved to the boar.

4. Licences to move sows to the boar shall be returnable to the issuing Authority within eight days from the date of issue of the licence.

5. Persons who are regular dealers in stock, including swine, may make application to Government Office to be registered as dealers in swine, and if approved, certificates of registration will be issued to such persons.

6. Registered dealers and Mart-owners shall keep a register, in the form prescribed in the Schedules to the Order, giving particulars of all swine purchased, sold, or dealt in, with the dates of all purchases and sales, &c.

7. The Registers to be kept at Marts and by registered dealers in swine, must on demand be produced for inspection to an Inspector under the Cattle Diseases Prevention Acts or to any Police Officer.

8. Where application is made through the post for licences, care should be taken to state clearly (1) the present address (2) the destination, and (3) the date on which it is desired to move the swine.

9. One licence will cover a box of young pigs for removal collectively either to or from a mart or to any one destination within the Island.

10. The copies of issued licences retained by the Clerks to the Village and Parish Commissioners shall be open at all reasonable times to inspection by an Inspector under the Cattle Diseases Prevention Acts or any Police Officer.

A PROCLAMATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the Cattle Diseases Prevention Acts, 1865 to 1903, I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of two members of the Council, do hereby Order as follows :—

1. No boar, pig, hog or sow (in this order included in the word "pig") may be removed from the premises in which it is now situate to other premises, unless a licence on the form prescribed in Schedule 1 hereof, signed by a Police Officer, or by a Clerk to the Commissioners of a Village or Parish District, authorizing the movement thereof, has been previously obtained.
2. A licence shall not be granted for the removal of any pig from one place to another (except for immediate slaughter, and except as provided in Clauses 6, 7 and 8 hereof), unless the pig in respect of which the licence is required shall have been at least 14 days on the premises from which it is desired the removal shall take place.
3. A Register in the form prescribed in Schedule 2 hereof shall be kept at every Mart, recording particulars of each pig brought into such Mart, and of the names and addresses of the seller and purchaser of every such pig, and of the dates of movement into and from such Mart.
4. Any person who is a regular dealer in stock, including pigs, may make application to Government Office to be registered as a dealer in swine, and if approved, the name of such person shall be registered and a Certificate of Registration issued to him.
5. A Register in the form prescribed in Schedule 3 hereof shall be kept by each person whose name has been registered at Government Office, and to whom a certificate of registration has been issued in accordance with Clause 4 hereof (in this Order referred to as a "registered dealer in swine") recording particulars of each pig purchased, sold or dealt in by him, with the name and address of every purchaser from him or seller to him of every pig, with the dates of the respective purchases and sales.
6. Notwithstanding anything contained in Clause 2 hereof, a registered dealer in swine shall not be required to keep fat or store pigs on his premises for the period specified in Clause 2 hereof, but may on licence move them at any time to any other place.
7. Notwithstanding anything contained in Clause 2 hereof, a licence may be issued to move sows to the boar, to be returnable to the issuing Authority within eight days from the date of issue of the licence.
8. Any pig may be moved on licence to a mart and from the mart to any new destination, or if not disposed of, back to the place from which it was moved to the mart, without being kept at the mart for the period specified in Clause 2.
9. The Registers to be kept under this Order at a Mart and by a Registered Dealer in swine, must, on demand, be produced for inspection to any Inspector under the Cattle Diseases Prevention Acts, or to any Police Officer.
10. The provisions of this Order shall not apply to any pig for export from the Isle of Man, in respect of which a movement licence under the Swine Fever (Movement from Isle of Man) Orders of 1908 and 1912, has been issued by an Inspector under the Cattle Diseases Prevention Acts, empowered by the Lieutenant-Governor in that behalf, or by an Inspector of the Local Authority of the District in which the place of destination specified in the licence is situate, empowered to grant such a licence under the Swine Fever (Regulation of Movement) Orders, made by the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries.
11. The Clerks to the Village and Parish Commissioners shall keep a record of all licences issued by them under this Order, in such form as may be from time to time prescribed by the Lieutenant-Governor, and such record shall be open at all times to the inspection of any Inspector under the Cattle Diseases Prevention Acts or of any Police Officer.
12. The unrepealed portions of the Order made by the Lieutenant-Governor on the 10th day of October, 1916, are hereby revoked and cancelled.
13. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of February, 1921.
