DEFENCE OF THE REALM.

BUTTER (DISTRIBUTION) ORDER, 1917.

DIRECTIONS.

In exercise of the powers reserved to him by the above Order, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the **LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR** hereby directs as follows :—

1. No Government Butter released for distribution under the Butter Distribution Scheme on or after February 7th, 1921, shall, until further notice, be sold by retail at a price exceeding 3s. Od. per lb.

2. The price fixed by this Direction is fixed on the basis that the cost of packing and packages is borne by the seller, and that no charge is made for giving credit or making delivery, and no Government Butter shall be sold on any other terms.
