HIS EXCELLENCY THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR wishes it to be publicly known that the Summer Time (Isle of Man) Act, 1916, will be in force during the year 1921, and the prescribed period will be from **2 a.m.** (Greenwich Mean Time) on Sunday, 3rd April, until **2 a.m.** (Greenwich Mean Time) on Monday, 3rd October.

**All clocks in the Isle of Man should be advanced one hour as from 2 a.m. on Sunday, 3rd April.**
