REVOCATION OF REGULATION 39G.

HIS MAJESTY THE KING has been graciously pleased, by Order in Council dated the 30th April, 1921, made under the provisions of the Isle of Man (War Legislation) Act, 1914, to extend to the Isle of Man the Order in Council dated the 22nd April, 1921, revoking the Defence of the Realm Regulation 39G, which prohibited the transfer of the registry of a British ship without the consent of the Board of Trade.
