## Isle of Man Coal (Distribution) Order, 1921.

# GENERAL LICENCE.

Licensed Dealers (Coal Merchants) for the purposes of the above Order, are hereby authorised to distribute Coal as under :—

### FOR DOMESTIC PURPOSES.

At the rate of one half cwt. per household per week. To facilitate distribution two weeks' ration (*i.e.*, one cwt.) may be delivered at one time where necessary.

### SICK PERSONS, ETC.

Where a medical certificate is produced, one cwt. additional Coal per week may be issued in respect of sick persons, aged persons, and young children of three years and under.

### FACTORIES AND WORKSHOPS.

At the rate authorised by the Government Secretary, on the Licensed Dealer submitting an application from the proprietor on the prescribed form.

### SHOPS, PUBLIC AND PRIVATE OFFICES.

At the rate of 25 per cent. of their normal average week's consumption for current year.

### HOSPITALS, NURSING HOMES, SCHOOLS, AND HOMES FOR THE AGED, ETC.

At the rate of 50 per cent. of their normal average weekly consumption for current year.

### COAL FOR THRESHING PURPOSES.

At the rate authorised on application to Government Office.

### HOTELS, BOARDING-HOUSES, AND LODGING-HOUSES.

At the rate authorised on application by the dealer to Government Office.

### STEAMSHIPS OTHER THAN PLEASURE VESSELS.

Such supply of Coal as is specially authorized on application by the dealer to Government Office.

Cases not provided for herein, will be referred by the Licensed Dealer to the Government Secretary for consideration by the Lieutenant-Governor.

The General Licence dated 4th April, 1921, is hereby cancelled.
