WARNING

TO PURVEYORS OF MEAT AND FISH.

It having been brought to notice that in certain quarters the practice obtains in the Island of selling mutton as lamb, chilled meat as fresh meat, and chilled fish as fresh fish, dealers in these commodities are warned that such practice constitutes a serious breach of the law, as anyone committing such an offence is liable to be proceeded against for obtaining money by false pretences.

Any person found, after this warning, infringing the law in this respect, will be proceeded against.
