DEFENCE OF THE REALM.

REVOCATION OF LICENSED PREMISES (CLOSING) No. 2 ORDER, 1921.

In view of the fact that His Majesty the King has, under the powers afforded by the Termination of the Present War (Definition) Act, 1918, which Act extends to the Isle of Man, made an Order in Council dated the 10th day of August, 1921, fixing the date for the termination of the War (except as regards the Ottoman Empire) as the 31st August, 1921, in consequence of which the Defence of the Realm Acts and Regulations cease on midnight of that day, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, as Competent Military Authority, has issued an Order (a copy of which is appended), dated the 20th August, 1921, revoking the Licensed Premises (Closing) No. 2 Order, 1921.

On and from the 1st day of September, 1921, the opening and closing hours of Licensed Premises will cease to be governed by the Defence of the Realm Regulations and Orders made thereunder, and will be subject to the provisions of the Licensing Acts as to hours of opening.

DEFENCE OF THE REALM REGULATIONS.

1. The Order made by me on the 6th July, 1921, entitled "The Licensed Premises (Closing) No 2 Order, 1921," shall be and the same is hereby revoked and cancelled as from the 1st September, 1921.

2. This Order may be cited as "The Licensed Premises Closing (Revocation) Order, 1921."
