DANGEROUS DRUGS ACT, 1920.

Prohibition of Importation of Dangerous Drugs into the Isle of Man except to persons licensed by the Lieutenant-Governor.

Pending the passage of an Insular Bill regulating the supply of Dangerous Drugs, THE SECRETARY OF STATE has made a provisional regulation (a copy of which is appended) under the above-named Act, prohibiting the supply of the undermentioned drugs to persons in the Isle of Man, except to persons licensed for the purpose by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Island, and then only to such persons in accordance with the terms and conditions of the licences issued to them.

The drugs to which the Regulation applies are raw (including powdered and granulated), prepared, and medicinal opium, morphine, cocaine, ecgonine, and diamorphine (commonly known as heroin), and their respective salts, and any preparation, admixture, extract, or other substance containing not less than one-fifth per cent. of morphine or one-tenth per cent. of cocaine, ecgonine, or diamorphine. (The percentage in the case of morphine shall be calculated as in respect of anhydrous morphine).

Members of the medical and dental professions, chemists, and other persons desiring to be licensed to receive supplies of the above-named drugs should address a written application to the Government Secretary, Isle of Man, stating the names of the particular drugs of which they wish to obtain a supply, together with the maximum monthly quantities required.

DANGEROUS DRUGS ACT, 1920.

PROVISIONAL REGULATION MADE BY THE SECRETARY
OF STATE.

I hereby certify in pursuance of Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that, on account of urgency, the following Regulation should come into immediate operation, and in pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1920, I hereby make the following Regulation to come into operation forthwith as a provisional regulation :—

No person shall supply or procure, or offer to supply or procure, any of the drugs to which the said Act applies to or for any person in the Isle of Man, except to or for a person licensed for the purpose by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Island, nor to or for any person so licensed except in accordance with the terms and conditions of such licence.
