The Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Act, 1921.

APPLICATION TO ENGLAND AND IRELAND.

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor has, under the powers afforded by the above-named Act, made an Order, dated the 19th November, 1921, a copy of which is appended, applying the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Act, 1921, to England and Ireland.

His Excellency does not at present propose to make any regulations under Section 5 of the Act, and communications between one Court and another should be made direct by post in the ordinary way.

WHEREAS by the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Act, 1921, provision has been made for the enforcement in the Isle of Man of maintenance orders made by any Court in the United Kingdom or in any part of His Majesty's Dominions or a British Protectorate outside the Isle of Man to which the said Act extends.

AND WHEREAS by the said Act it is provided among other things that where the Governor is satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made by the Legislature of the United Kingdom or any part of His Majesty's Dominions or British Protectorate outside the Isle of Man for the enforcement within that part of maintenance orders made by Courts within the Isle of Man, the Governor may by order extend such Act to the United Kingdom or such part of His Majesty's Dominions or British Protectorate.

AND WHEREAS His Excellency is satisfied that the Legislature of the United Kingdom has made reciprocal provisions for the enforcement in England and Ireland of maintenance orders made by Courts within the Isle of Man.

NOW THEREFORE, the Lieutenant-Governor, by virtue and in exercise of the powers by the above recited Act in him vested, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

The Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Act, 1921, shall apply to England and Ireland.
