to be a Commission to enquire and report whether there is a possibility of

- (1) Reviving industries either defunct or in a state of decay,
- (2) Creating new industries, or
- (3) Stimulating and expanding industries.

The Commission has been requested to have special regard to the possibility of initiating, promoting or developing industries which can be carried on in the winter months; and to this end it has been suggested that they should survey and take evidence regarding all the resources and opportunities which actually exist on the Island, and suggest means for utilising them for the purpose in view.

Mr. J. R. Corrin, M.L.C., has been appointed Chairman of the Commission, and Mr. W. A. Latham, of Government Office, Secretary, to whom all communications on the subject should be addressed.
